

Fragments



On the night of October 2, 2010, nearly a million Torontonians and visitors to the city will have the opportunity to experience a collective art installation titled *Fragments* as part of this year's *Scotiabank Nuit Blanche*. Hundreds of personal items donated by survivors of genocide, torture, war crimes and other international human rights violations will be displayed at Lamport Stadium on King Street.

Survivors are invited to participate in Fragments by submitting up to five objects that represent their past experiences, or their experiences of living with these memories even now that they have found refuge in Canada. Families of murdered or disappeared persons are also invited to contribute. Some examples of items include clothing, documents, and photographs, but any object of personal relevance is welcome.

Every Monday from July 12th to September 20th (except for the statutory holidays on August 2nd and September 6th) between 3pm and 6pm at the Toronto Reference Library, Room B1 (concourse level), 789 Yonge Street (one block north of Bloor Street)

Objects can either be donated or loaned. All loaned objects will be returned to their owner after the exhibition ends on October 3rd, 2010. If you feel your item is too sentimental to donate or loan, you can bring it to the Toronto Reference Library during the designated times listed above to be photographed on-site. The photograph of your item will be included in the exhibition.

Your identity will be kept confidential, unless you ask that your name and/or story be included in the exhibition.
